Past Perfect

The past perfect is like a way to show what happened before something else in the past. Imagine you're telling a story about **two events** that happened in the past. The first event is like setting the stage for the second one.

Here's an example:

Event 1: I had studied for my exam.

Event 2: Then, I took the exam and aced it.

In this story, "I had studied for my exam" shows that studying happened before taking the exam. The "had studied" part is the past perfect, telling us about the action that happened first.
