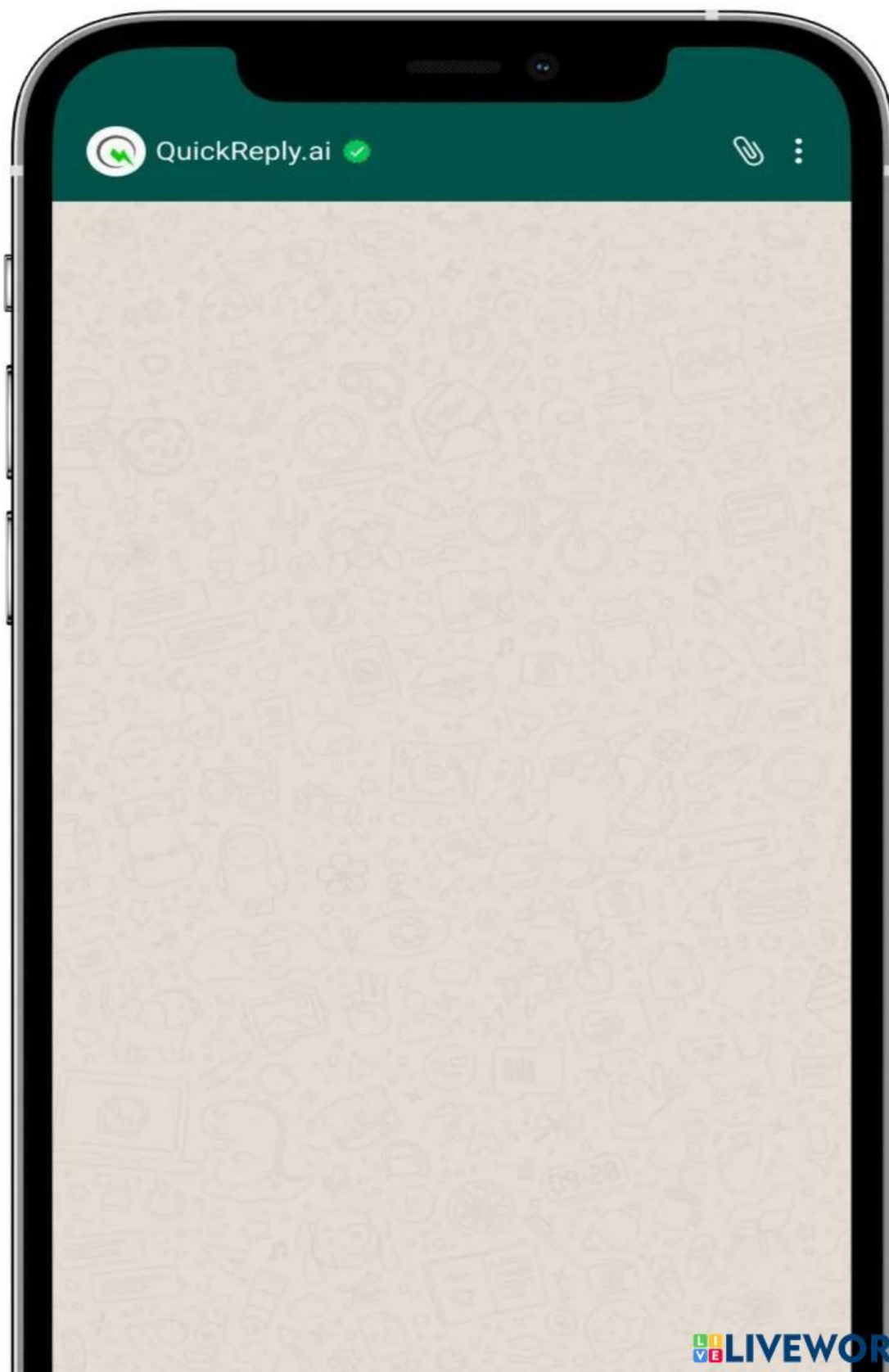


## Making Plans with Friends

**John:** No worries, Sara. Take your time.

**Emily:** Yeah, don't stress. **We'll** wait for you.

**Mark:** I hope you don't miss the bus, Sarah!

**Sarah:** Me too, Mark! But if I do, **I'll** just take a taxi.

**John:** Exactly, **we'll** see you when you get here.
