



tea	+	pot	→	teapot
pop	+	corn	→	popcorn
hand	+	bag	→	handbag
water	+	fall	→	waterfall

to help your narrative come to life.




	What does my topic look like? <i>If I drew a picture of it, what would I draw?</i>


