Adverbial phrases of frequency

I have a shower	once a day.
I drink coffee	twice a day.
I brush my teeth	three times a day.
I go to the cinema	once a week.
I go to football practice	twice a month.
We visit my aunt	three times a year.
I phone my friends	every day.
I go shopping	every Saturday.

Фрази за честота

Има и някои фрази, които посочват колко често се извършва дадено действие. Те винаги се поставят след действието, което описват.

*I eat crisps **three times a week**.*

*She goes to the cinema **every Sunday**.*

How often am I late?

How often are you/we/they tired?

How often is he/she/it the first to arrive?

- с глагол **to be (am/is/are)**:

***How often** are you late?*

- с други глаголи:

***How often** do you **play** tennis?*

***How often** does Sam **eat** breakfast?*

Like and dislike + verb-ing

*I **like** reading a book.*

*I **love** **playing** computer games.*

*I **don't like/dislike** playing football.*

*I **hate** **revising** English vocabulary.*

Like and dislike + verb-ing

Конструкцията **like/love/dislike/don't like/hate + глагол + -ing** употребяваме, за да говорим за неща, които харесваме, не харесваме, обичаме или мразим да правим.

Образуване

Глаголите **like, love, hate** се спрягат като самостоятелни глаголи в сег.просто време + **-ing** форма на глагола след тях. (За правопис за образуване на **-ing** форма – виж Unit 7).

- положителна форма: *I **like** reading a book.*

*He **likes** listening to music.* (3 л.ед.ч.)

- отрицателна форма: *I **don't like** reading a book.*

*He **doesn't like** listening to music.*

** I **don't like** reading a book. = I **dislike** reading a book.*

- въпросителна форма: ***Do you like** reading a book?*

***Does he like** listening to music?*

- кратки отговори: *Yes, I **do**. / No, I **don't**.*

*Yes, he **does**. / No, he **doesn't**.*

Внимание – често допускани грешки!

*~~I like cook.~~ X I **like cooking.** ✓*

*~~I'm like swimming.~~ X I **like swimming.** ✓*

- Същите глаголи **like/love/dislike/don't like/hate** можем за употребим и със съществително.

*I **like playing** football. (I like football.)*

*I **hate going** to school. (I hate school.)*

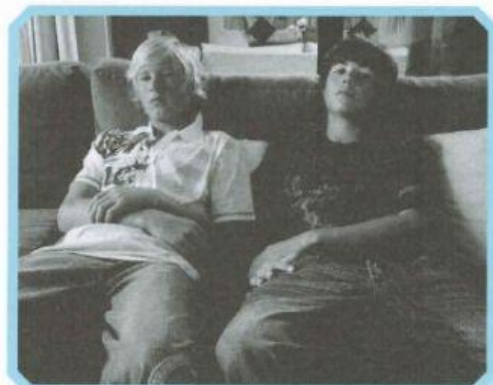
