<b>talk</b>	to speak in order to give information, express feelings or share ideas. You talk to somebody in order to be friendly or to ask their advice.	розмовляти, бесідувати, говорити, спілкуватися
<b>discuss</b>	(rather formal) to talk and share ideas on a subject or problem with other people, especially in order to decide something	обговорювати, дискутувати
<b>speak (spoke, spoken)</b>	to talk to somebody about something; to have a conversation with somebody. You speak to somebody about something to try to achieve a particular goal or to tell them to do something.	говорити, висловлюватися, говорити; (of) згадувати
