### will

I'll send you a photo. (spontaneous decision)

I won't miss the British weather. (prediction)

### be going to

I'm going to work there. (plan)

It's going to be great. (prediction based on facts)

### Present Continuous

My uncle is starting a new business this summer. (arrangement)

### Present Simple

My flight leaves the day after we finish school. (schedule)

Look at the future forms of *can* and *must*.

I can go swimming. → I'll be able to go swimming.

You must come and visit me. → You'll have to come and visit me.
