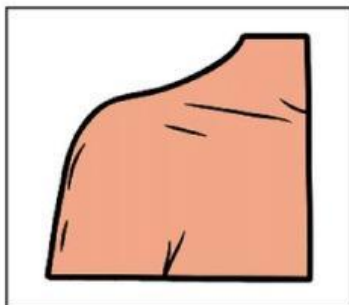

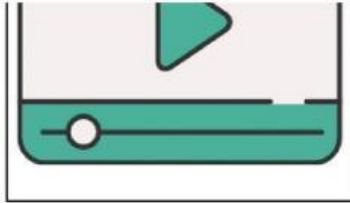

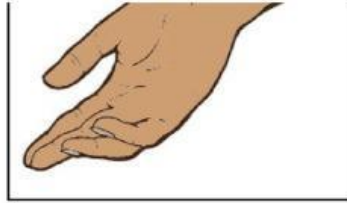

Then Charlie said, 'Now I've got to do my homework. Can you help me, Dad? I've got to write about the moon.'

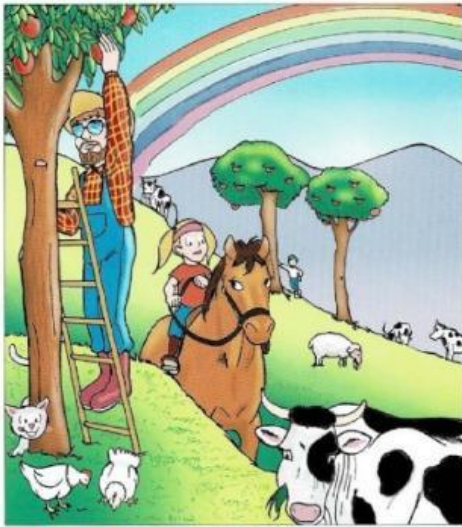
'Sorry, Charlie,' Dad said. 'I can't help but look! Here's a good website!'
