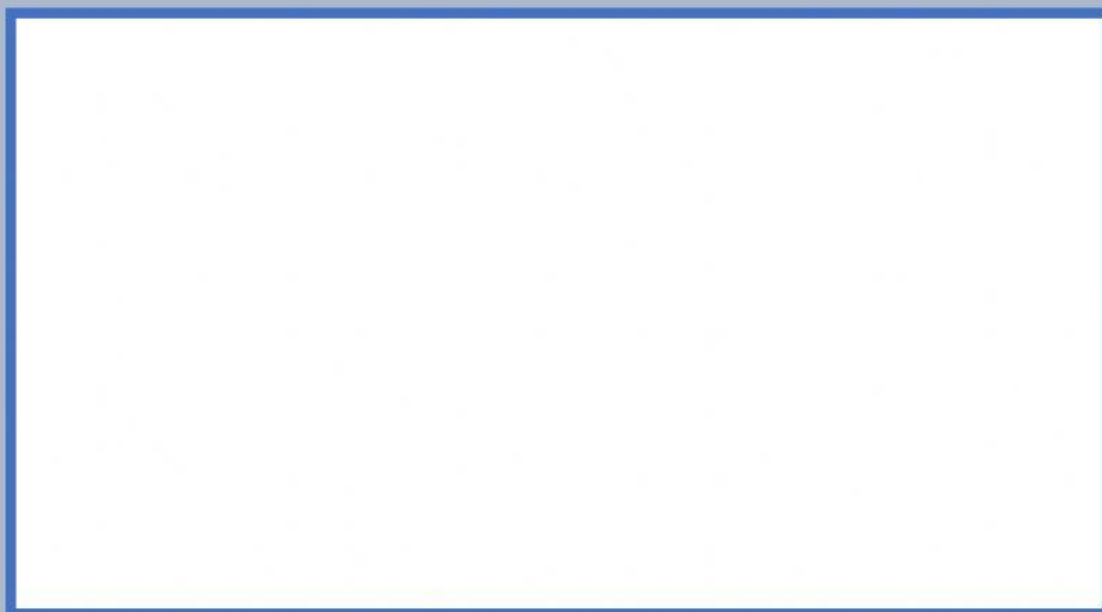

'I'm a lion! You're a mouse! What can you do?' The lion laughed, very hard, and the mouse ran away.





