a list of the food that is available at a restaurant or to be served at a meal.

pour

a woman whose job is to serve customers at their tables in a restaurant, etc.

menu

sweet food eaten at the end of a meal.

waitress

a tool that has a handle with a shallow bowl at the end, used for mixing, serving and eating food.

spoon

to serve a drink by letting it flow from a container into a cup or glass.

napkin

a piece of cloth or paper used at meals for protecting your clothes and cleaning your lips and fingers

whisk

a set of instructions that tells you how to cook something and the ingredients

recipe

to mix liquids, eggs, etc. into a stiff, light mass, using a fork or special tool.

dessert

a public performance of music

instrument

a musical instrument in the shape of a pipe that you blow into, with holes that you cover with your fingers.

drum

a musical instrument with strings, which you hold under your chin and play with a bow.

violin

a brass musical instrument made of a curved metal tube that you blow into, with three valves for changing the note.

musician

a person who plays a musical instrument or writes music, especially as a job.

composer

a person who writes music, especially classical music.

producer

a person or company that arranges for somebody to make a programme for radio or television, or a record, CD, etc.

trumpet

a musical instrument. You play it by hitting it with sticks or with your hands.

concert

an object used for producing musical sounds.

recorder

a great change in conditions, ways of working, beliefs, etc. that affects large numbers of people.

fossil

no longer in existence.

carnivore

any animal that eats only plants.

evolve

the structure of bones that supports the body of a person or an animal; a model of this structure.

predator

any animal that eats meat.

extinct

an animal, a bird, etc. that is hunted, killed, and eaten by another.

prey

To develop gradually, especially from a simple to a more complicated form.

revolution

an animal that kills and eats other animals.

skeleton

the parts of a dead animal or a plant that have become hard and turned into rock.
