WHAT IS FUTURE TENSE?

We use "going to" to talk about plans decided before the moment of speaking.

For Example:

- I'm going to be an astronaut.
- I'm going to study in London University.

STRUCTURES

- ✓ Subject + to be going to + verb in base form + complement + T. E.
I am going to travel next year.
- ✗ Subject + to be **not** + going to + verb in base form + complement + T.E.
She is not going to study abroad this year.
- ? to be + Subject + going to + verb in base form + complement + T. E. + ?
