## Using a wheelchair for the first time

If you have a physical disability, or if currently, you 1 \_\_\_\_\_ (**recover**) from an injury or disease, you may need to use a wheelchair. If you 2 \_\_\_\_\_ (**think**) about ways to use a wheelchair properly, this site will help you find information to help you with first time wheelchair use.

- a Make sure you 3 \_\_\_\_\_ (**be**) comfortable. This might sound obvious, but being comfortable means that you can use the chair in the best possible way.
- b Speaking of comfort, experienced wheelchair users 4 \_\_\_\_\_ (**know**) that a cushion is one of the best things you can buy if you are going to use it for a long time!
- c Never travel too fast. Again, this sounds obvious, but even if you 5 \_\_\_\_\_ (**need**) to get somewhere quickly, go slowly and safely, or you could have an accident.
- d 6 \_\_\_\_\_ (**you / have**) problems moving your wheelchair properly? It might be because there is not enough air in the wheels. Always make sure that the wheels are properly inflated.

Remember that a wheelchair is a vehicle, and like all vehicles, you need to be safe!
