The farmer showed the children his animals. The cows were in a big (3) outside and the sheep, goats and chickens were inside. 'Do you have any questions?' said the farmer.


'Yes,' said Jane. 'What do you feed your goats?'

'Different (4),' said the farmer.


'Well, why is that goat eating a scarf?' asked Jane.




