- They have a mouth and some tentacles to catch animals.

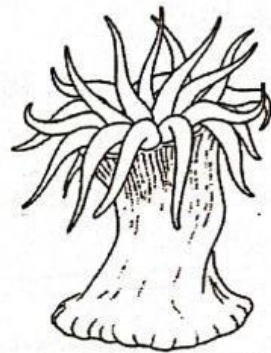

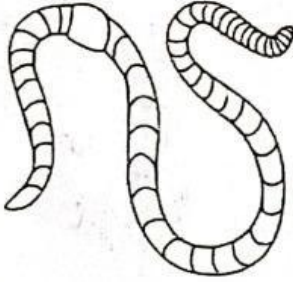
3. SPONGES or PORIFEROS

Sponges

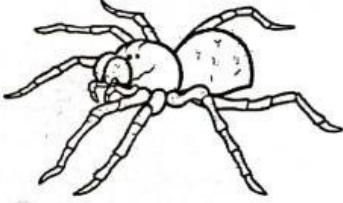
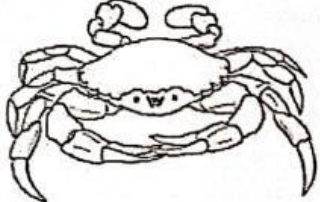
- They are aquatic.
