**Section R2 (13 marks)**

**A Different Kind of Football**

*Futsal* is a Spanish word which means 'room football'. People first played the game in Uruguay in 1930, when a teacher wanted a new sport to play inside. It became popular in Brazilian cities because there were no big spaces outside for playing football.

In a *futsal* match, only five team players play on the court at once. Each team has seven other players off the court, waiting to play. That means that there are 12 players altogether in each *futsal* team. They can change players at any time. *Futsal* is also different from normal football because teams play with a smaller, heavier ball. A match lasts for two halves of twenty minutes.

There are now ten million players in 100 countries. The highest number of players is in Brazil, but many people also play in Japan and Holland. The first international competition was in 1965, when Paraguay won. The FIFA *futsal* world cup started in 1989 and happens every four years. Since then, Brazil has won five times and Spain has won three. Spain were the winners in February 2016.

*Futsal* is a fast game. It helps young players to develop their football skills and improve their fitness. Many famous footballers like Ronaldo and Messi began playing *futsal* as children, before they started playing football.
