

Present perfect simple and continuous

When Mr. Jones comes back home, he finds his son Tom sitting on the stairs in front of their house.

Complete their dialogue.

Tom: Where so long, Dad? (be)

Dad: I late today. (work) What's the matter?

Tom: I my keys, I'm afraid. (lose)

Dad: Do you mean that? You your keys since you were born. How long you here? (lose, wait)

Tom: For two hours.

Dad: And what you all that time? (do)

Tom: Nothing, really.

Dad: Are you sure that you the keys? (lose)

Tom: Yes, I am.

Dad: you your bag? (try)

Tom: My bag? I don't think ... Oh no, my keys!

Dad: Oh, dear. You here all afternoon doing nothing and you into your bag! (sit, not even look)
