Jaguar is a type of large cat belonging to the genus *Panthera*. This animal is the third wild cat after the tiger and lion, and is also the largest cat in the Western Hemisphere. This animal covers northern Mexico, across Central America to Paraguay, northern and southern Argentina.

The jaguar is a predatory animal that has an extraordinarily strong bite so that even a turtle's shell is so strong that 'it' can penetrate it in one bite. They live by preying on deer, tapirs, dogs, foxes and also aquatic animals such as fish, even large anaconda snakes can become their prey.

Jaguars have a body size of around 1.1 - 1.9 meters or the equivalent of 6 times the body length of the cats we usually encounter around us. The jaguar's age range is 12-15 years, its body weight is around 160 kg with nimble and agile movements. The power he has is very strong according to the native American language (Indian language), namely jaguar which means he who finishes off prey in just one jump.
