

Shipping Manifest		1. The height & width is consistent and has lengths of 20, 40 & 45 feet
Bill of Lading		2. Form provided to the government which verifies that the goods were produced within a country
Intermodal Transportation		3. Trade agreement between the USA, Mexico & Canada
ISO Container		4. Straddles the containers to quickly move trailers between road & rail vehicles
Gantry Crane		5. Products produced in a foreign country to be sold in this country
Skeletal Trailer		6. Responsible for enforcing laws with regard to both incoming and outgoing cargo
Imports		7. For international shipments, this must contain port of entry, currency used, country of origin & additional charges or discounts
US Customs & Border Protection		8. Semi-trailer designed to carry ISO containers
World Trade Organization		9. Document which includes the customer address, invoice numbers and package weights
NAFTA		10. Document used by a carrier or shipping department and acknowledges that specific goods have been received on board for shipment
Commercial Invoice		11. International organization that supervises global trade
Certificate of Origin		12. The introduction of standardized containers and pallets allows for quick transfer of loads between modes of transport
