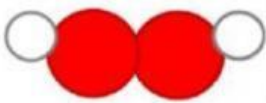


Classification

Compound = two or more types of elements bonded together, ex: Carbon Dioxide (CO_2)

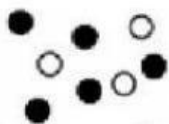
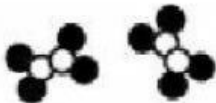
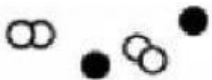
