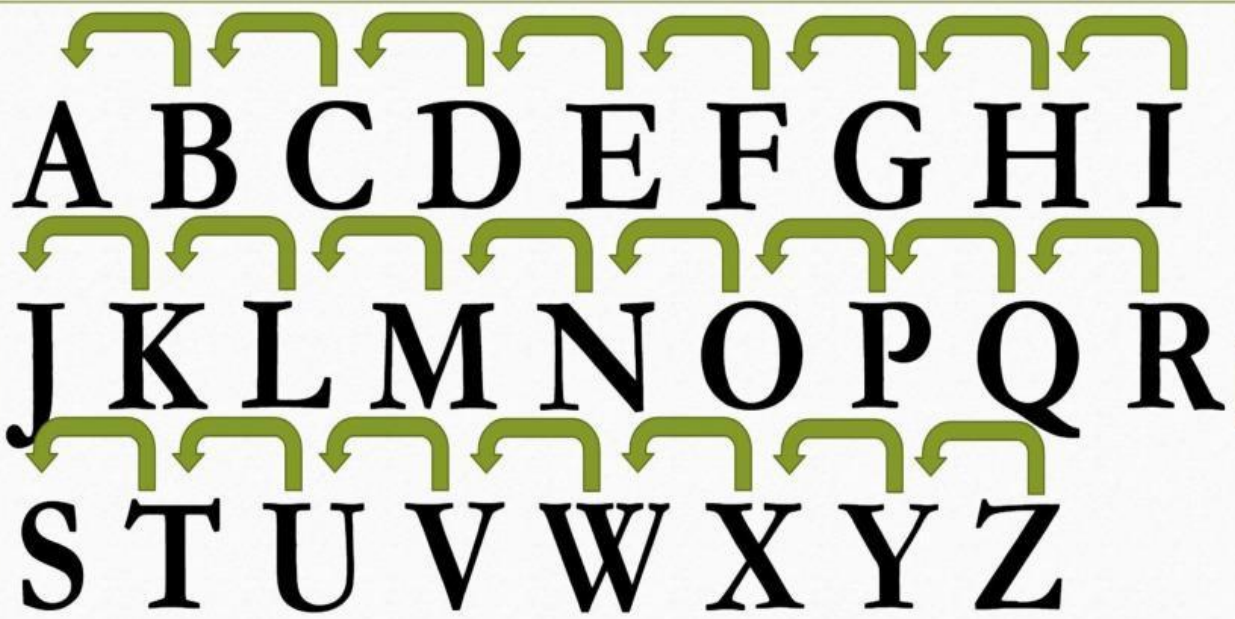
use to support or prove a reason; statistics, facts,
