

They inaugurate the collective exhibition "United Artists" in Suchitoto



The Center for Art for Peace in Suchitoto, Cuscatlán, opened its doors to more than 19 visual artists to exhibit their works in a collective exhibition that opened on April 7.

"United Artists" is the title of this pictorial exhibition housed in the CAP chapel, which has aroused the curiosity of both locals and outsiders. In the venue, a series of works of different sizes, techniques, and themes can be observed, painting the space with various colors.

During the inauguration, the artists received a certificate of recognition from CAP for their participation in this recent exhibition, which will be open to the public until June 30 of the current year. Admission is free.

In addition, attendees had the opportunity to tour the venue and have the exhibitors speak to them about their works of art.
