### will

- predictions (we think something will happen)  
④ He **will be** a good doctor.
- I believe they **will win** this match.
- instant decisions (taken while speaking)  
④ A: "We don't have sugar"  
B: "I'll buy some then."
- promises and refusals  
④ I **will help** you but I **won't lend** you any money.
- offers  
④ I'll **carry** your bag. / Will I **carry** your bag?
- requests  
④ Will you **open** the door please?

### be going to

- predictions (we see - present evidence)  
④ Slow down! We're **going to have** an accident!
- Look at the clouds. It's **going to rain**.
- decisions (taken before now - intentions/plans)  
④ Are you **going** to watch the game tonight?

### present simple

- timetabled events  
④ The train **leaves** at 4 o'clock.
- The exams **start** next week.
- future time clauses (when/ as soon as/until, etc.)  
④ I'll **retire** when I **am** 70. (NOT **when I'll be 70**).  
④ Call me as **soon as** you **arrive**.

### present continuous

- plans (arrangements have been made)  
④ I'm **flying** to New York tomorrow morning.
- I'm **seeing** the dentist at 6.
- We **are getting** married next week.
