We're <b>going to have</b> an accident! ➤ Look at the clouds. It's <b>going to rain</b> .	<b>timetabled events</b> ➤ The train <b>leaves</b> at 4 o'clock. ➤ The exams <b>start</b> next week.
<b>instant decisions (taken while speaking)</b> ➤ A: "We don't have sugar" B: "I'll <b>buy</b> some then."	<b>decisions (taken before now - intentions/plans)</b> ➤ Are you <b>going to watch</b> the game tonight?	<b>future time clauses (when/ as soon as/until, etc.)</b> ➤ I'll retire <b>when I am</b> 70. (NOT <b>when I'll be</b> 70). ➤ Call me <b>as soon as you arrive</b> .
<b>promises and refusals</b> ➤ I <b>will</b> help you but I <b>won't</b> lend you any money.		
<b>offers</b> ➤ I'll <b>carry</b> your bag. / <b>Will I</b> carry your bag?		
<b>requests</b> ➤ <b>Will you open</b> the door please?		
	<b>present continuous</b> <b>plans (arrangements have been made)</b> ➤ I'm <b>flying</b> to New York tomorrow morning. ➤ I'm <b>seeing</b> the dentist at 6. ➤ We <b>are getting</b> married next week.
