A **pronoun** is a word that takes the place of a noun or nouns. The words **he**, **she**, **it**, **we**, **you**, and **they** are pronouns.

Carlos is a vet. **He** helps animals.
He takes the place of the noun **Carlos**.

Keesha and **Paul** are zookeepers. **They** also help animals.
They takes the place of the nouns **Keesha** and **Paul**.
