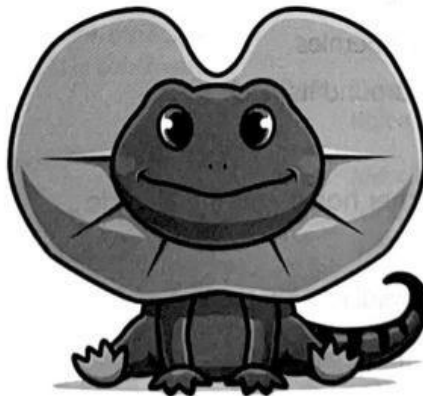

He was nicknamed 'Spiderman' because his long arms helped him save many balls in national and international matches. He was tall and lean. He had black curly hair, and he used to keep a moustache. His most memorable moment was beating Korea 2-1 in Kuala Lumpur in 1980 to qualify for the Olympic Games in Moscow.</p>
<b>C</b>	<p><b>Harith Iskander</b></p> <p>He has been voted Malaysia's top comedian. Born in Johor Bahru in 1966, he is also an actor, television host, director and writer. He has a round face and big sparkling eyes. He has a fair complexion. Sometimes, he keeps a short beard and has the bald look nowadays. He is not lean, and his arms are big. His best moments were when he won Asia's Best Stand-up Comedian Award in 2014, and the World's Funniest Person Award in 2016.</p>


