


Pythagoras' Theorem



The hypotenuse is
OPPOSITE the right
angle.

The longest side
of a right-angled
triangle is called
the hypotenuse

In any right-angled triangle, the square of
the hypotenuse is equal to the sum of the
squares on the other two sides

$$c^2 = a^2 + b^2$$
