Emerson's ideas had a great effect on Thoreau. Thoreau began to write. He wrote poems and essays. But working at the pencil factory was hard work. Thoreau wanted to be closer to nature and to write. So he went to live in a cabin by Walden Pond in Concord, Massachusetts. He lived in the cabin for more than two years.



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
