4. Jackson has 187 marbles to share with his 6 cousins. If he wants to give the same number of marbles to each cousin, how many marbles will each cousin get, and how many marbles will remain with Jackson?
5. Lily collected 153 seashells at the beach and wants to display them in jars with 34 seashells each. How many jars will she need, and will there be any seashells left unused?
