have/get something done ...

We use the structure **have something done** when we arrange for somebody to do something for us. Here are a few more examples:

My car was dirty so I **had** it **washed**.

We didn't want to cook, so we **had** a pizza **delivered**.

My computer is working again. I managed to **have** it **fixed**.

In informal English, we can also use **get** instead of **have**.

My car was dirty so I **got** it **washed**.

We didn't want to cook, so we **got** a pizza **delivered**.

We can also use **have something done** when somebody does something bad to us:

James **had** his nose **broken** in a fight.
