Between

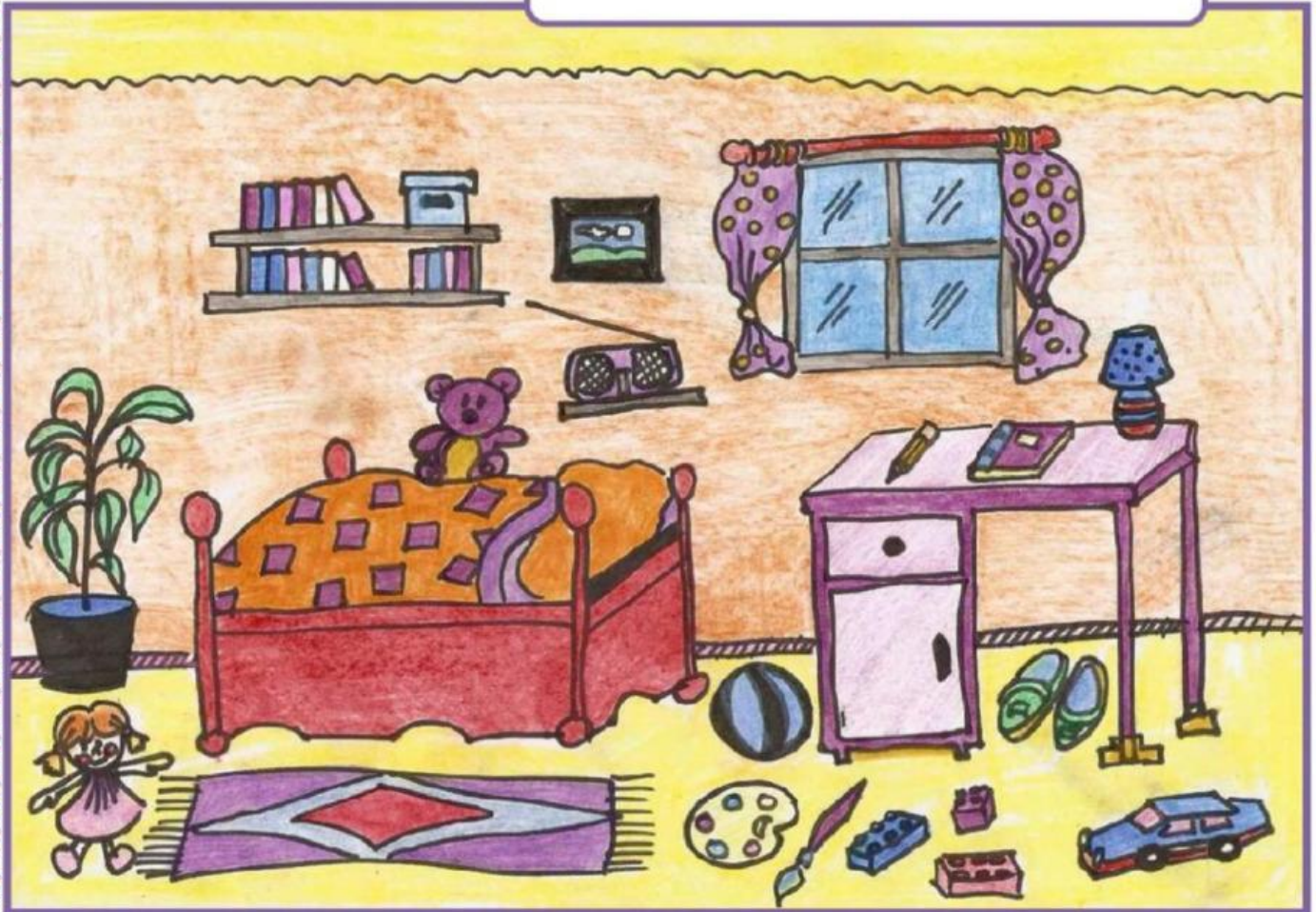
Between means between two or more objects, which can be people, places, or others.

Prepositions of place

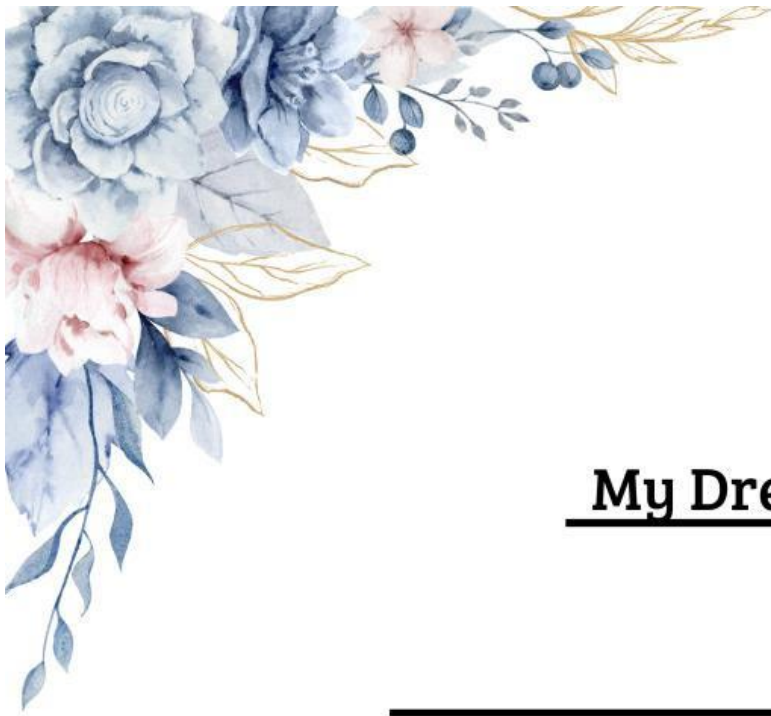
In on between under in front of
