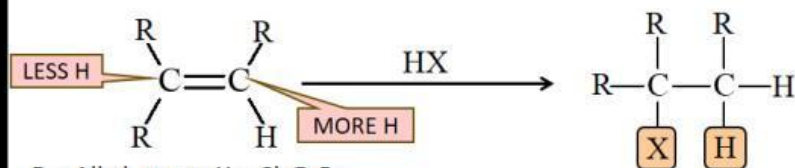


REACTIONS OF ALKENES

HYDROHALOGENATION OF UNSYMMETRICAL ALKENES

Addition of HX to the carbon-carbon double bond of alkene.



R = Alkyl group X = Cl @ Br

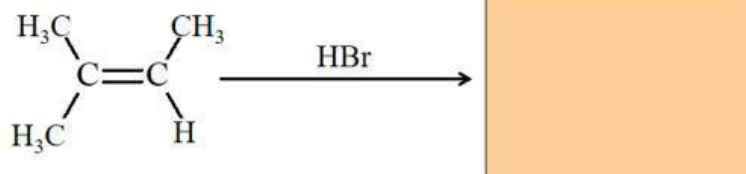
Reagent & Conditions : HX (HCl @ HBr)

Rule : H is added to C= with more H and X is added to C= with less H without changing its carbon chain.
