### Worksheet - I

For the following problems, four calculations are given. Only one of the calculations leads to the correct answer. Find which one leads to the correct answer.

1. There are 16 glasses on a table. 4 of them are full of water and the rest are empty. How many glasses on the table are empty?  
a)  $16 \div 4$                       b)  $16 + 4$                       c)  $16 - 4$                       d)  $16 \times 4$
2. 45 toffees were equally distributed among 9 children. What is the number of toffees got by each child?  
a)  $45 \times 9$                       b)  $45 \div 9$                       c)  $45 - 9$                       d)  $45 + 9$
3. A school has 5 sections of Class I. Each section has 30 students. How many students are studying in Class I?  
a)  $30 + 5$                       b)  $30 \div 5$                       c)  $30 \times 5$                       d)  $30 - 5$
4. There are 55 children playing in a park. 5 more join them. How many children are playing in the park?

5. If 5 toffees are to be given to each child. How many toffees are required for 35 children?

6. 5 students can sit on a bench. How many benches are needed for 120 students?

7. 32 boys and 43 girls went to a camp. How many children were at the camp?
