Anyone who has had poor nights of rest can have less energy the next days. For example, people who regularly get fewer than seven hours of sleep per night have a higher risk of diseases such as diabetes, obesity and high blood pressure. **They** are major factors for developing heart attacks and stroke. People who do not have good sleep patterns may also have a higher risk for cardiovascular disease, or heart-related ones. Lack of sleep makes your immune system weakened and increases your chance of getting ill.
