

Direct Objects

The direct object is the direct “receiver” of the verb.

It is the thing or person that is having the verb done to them.

Example:

Subject Action Verb Direct Object

Bob shoots a Steven.

In the above example the action (shooting) is moving from Bob (the shooter) to Steven (the target).
