Countries around the world are witnessing the 1 _____ of new information and communication technologies which are poised to radically change the relationship between citizens and Governments. Emerging evidence indicates that countries that have undergone "11 _____ transparency" efforts coupled with participatory mechanisms are more likely to respond to people's needs in ways that will improve their lives. Among its main benefits, budget

transparency has the potential to lead to greater fiscal 12 _____ and performance as well as cheaper international credit, improved allocations of resources which will translate into better provision of public services, particularly in social sectors (health, education etc.); while limiting 13 _____ and wasteful spending that will have a positive impact in overall good governance 14 _____.
