Affirmative

1. Afirmativo: existe una **única conjugación en pasado** para todos los pronombres; excepto con el verbo "to be" que tiene 2 formas (**was / were**).

SUBJECT	VERB
I / you / we / they	lived ...
he / she / it	lived ...

Past I **lived** in a small apartment.Past He **lived** in a big house.

Negative

2. Negativo: se coloca el auxiliar negativo "didn't" delante del verbo que va en infinitivo. (**ya no en su forma de pasado**)

SUBJECT	AUXILIARY	VERB	Past	Negative
I / you / we / they	didn't	live	We didn't need	a dictionary.
he / she / it	didn't	play	Jack didn't want	to go.
