A conjunction is a joining word. It can join words, phrases, or sentences together. The word "and" is a conjunction. We use "and" to join similar ideas or to add information.

word+word	apples <b>and</b> oranges
phrase+phrase	a red flower <b>and</b> the blue sky go to school <b>and</b> make friends
sentence+sentence	I am from Korea, <b>and</b> Ben is from the U.K.

(\*Remember to add a comma before "and" when two sentences are joined.)
