A conjunction is a joining word. It can join words, phrases, or sentences together. The word "and" is a conjunction. We use "and" to join similar ideas or to add information.

|-------------------|--|
| word+word         | apples <b>and</b> oranges  |
| phrase+phrase     | a red flower <b>and</b> the blue sky<br>go to school <b>and</b> make friends |
| sentence+sentence | I am from Korea, <b>and</b> Ben is from the U.K.                             |
