Vocabulary Builder

Phrasal verbs with *up* and *down*

Phrasal verbs with *up* often mean 'more'.

speed up = go faster *turn up* = make louder
warm up = be/make warmer

Phrasal verbs with *down* often mean 'less'.

slow down = go more slowly *turn down* = make quieter
cool down = make cooler
