Story Plan

- Title – Write an attractive title and headline (topic sentence).
- Where (Setting) - Describe the location where your story is going to take place.
- Who (Characters) - Who is going to be there?
- What is happening (Complication) – What problem will this people face?
- Problem solving (Resolution) – How will the problem be fixed?
- End – How will your story end?

Checklist:

- Plan your writing thoroughly: organize your ideas, write an introduction, main body and conclusion.
- Write a catchy title.
- Use a wide range of vocabulary, punctuation and sentence structures.
- Ensure that your handwriting is neat and legible.
- Read through your work. Remember to check your spelling, punctuation and grammar and neatly correct any errors.
