Greece welcomed 30.1 million visitors in 2017 and 33.7 million visitors are expected in 2018, making Greece one of the most visited countries in Europe and the world.

Greece has 752 thermal springs. Many have been classified as therapeutic by the National Institute for Geographical and Mineral Research.

Popular for their therapeutic properties, Ancient spa resorts and thermal springs are located throughout the country, from quaint villages to peaceful resorts in lush green surroundings.

Greece's culinary influence is very prominent throughout Europe. The country's traditional signature dishes have been greatly influenced by both Eastern and Western cultures.
