

Order the paragraphs according to the story in the movie.

	Doc Brown invites Marty to the Twin Pines Mall to witness the time machine's first test. Doc explains that the car requires plutonium to generate the 1.21 gigawatts of electricity needed for time travel. During the test, Libyan terrorists, from whom Doc stole the plutonium, arrive and shoot him. Marty escapes in the DeLorean and accidentally activates the time machine, sending himself to November 5, 1955.
(1)	Teenager Marty McFly lives in Hill Valley, California, in 1985. His family struggles with various issues, and Marty himself is a typical high school student with a passion for music and skateboarding. He is friends with eccentric scientist Dr. Emmett "Doc" Brown, who has invented a time machine built into a DeLorean car.
	Marty convinces the skeptical 1955 Doc Brown about the time machine by proving he knows details about the future. They work on a plan to get George to stand up to Biff Tannen, a local bully, and win Lorraine's affection, thus ensuring Marty's birth. Despite numerous challenges, Marty succeeds in bringing George and Lorraine together at the "Enchantment Under the Sea" dance.
	Marty wakes up the next day to find his family's circumstances greatly improved: his father is a successful author, his mother is fit and happy, and his siblings are prosperous. Biff is now a subservient car dealer. Just as Marty enjoys his new reality, Doc arrives from the future, insisting they must travel to 2015 to resolve an issue with Marty's future children, setting up the sequel.
	In 1955, Marty encounters his teenage parents and unintentionally disrupts their first meeting. This jeopardizes his own existence as his mother, Lorraine, becomes infatuated with him instead of his father, George. Marty seeks out the younger Doc Brown to help him return to 1985 and to fix the timeline.
	On the night of the storm, the lightning strike successfully powers the DeLorean, sending Marty back to 1985. He arrives just in time to witness the terrorists attack Doc. However, Doc survives, having read Marty's warning letter and worn a bulletproof vest. Marty reunites with Doc, who drops him back home.
	With the timeline repaired, Marty and Doc focus on getting Marty back to 1985. Since plutonium is unavailable in 1955, they plan to harness a lightning strike predicted to hit the Hill Valley clock tower. Marty writes a warning letter to Doc about his future death at the hands of the terrorists.
