6. It contains the poisons amanita and phalloidin which can cause kidney and liver failure and kill a person within six hours of eating it.

7. It is so poisonous that people have been killed by eating meat roasted on its sticks.

8. It belongs to the parsley family but it is extremely poisonous. It is said to be the plant that was used to kill the ancient Greek philosopher, Socrates.
