







# THE RESPIRATORY SYSTEM

Touch  and listen .

<div> <div>INHALATION</div> <div>EXHALED AIR</div> <div>EXHALATION</div> <div>INHALED AIR</div> </div>		<b>NOSE and MOUTH</b>	We breathe in air through our <u>nose</u> and <u>mouth</u> .
		<b>TRACHEA or WINDPIPE</b>	Air travels down our <u>trachea</u> or <u>windpipe</u> .
		<b>BRONCHI</b>	The trachea divides in two branches called <u>bronchi</u> .
		<b>LUNGS</b>	Each of the bronchi leads to one of our <u>lungs</u> . In the lungs, oxygen passes to the blood and carbon dioxide passes to the lungs to go out of the body.

Our body needs

**OXYGEN.**

It gives us energy.

Our body doesn't need

**CARBON DIOXIDE.**

It's a waste substance.
