

Reflexive Pronouns Exercise

Rule:

Reflexive pronouns are used when the subject and object of a verb are the same. They refer back to the subject of the sentence. Here are the reflexive pronouns:

- myself
- yourself
- himself
- herself
- itself
- ourselves
- yourselves
- themselves

Example:

- I hurt **myself** while playing soccer. (The subject is "I" and the object is "myself")
