**Economic Integration between ASEAN and Other Countries**

(1) \_\_\_\_\_ economic integration between ASEAN and East Asian countries often is called "ASEAN+1" (ASEAN+China, ASEAN+Japan, or ASEAN+South Korea), ASEAN+3 (ASEAN+China, Japan and South Korea) and the East Asia Summit (ASEAN+6, that is mainland China, Japan, South Korea, New Zealand, Australia and India). In terms of (2) \_\_\_\_\_ economic and trade liberalization, ASEAN has signed FTAs or comprehensive economic cooperation agreements (3) \_\_\_\_\_ mainland China, Japan, South Korea, New Zealand, Australia and India. The ASEAN-China Free Trade Area has been fully implemented in 2010.
