READING

12 Read the text.

Most schools have classrooms, a cafeteria, and a gymnasium. But there is one kind of school that doesn't – a forest school!

At Willow Park forest school, boys and girls study in the woods with trees all around them. Students usually start at the school when they are five years old. They learn about the natural world and have fun playing outside.

The school day is short for young students. It ends at 12:30 p.m. When students are eleven years old, school starts at 8:00 a.m. and ends at 5:00 p.m. That's a long day!

In the morning, students study subjects like math, English, science, and music. But they study outside in the forest! At lunchtime, they have a break, but they don't go home. They cook their own food over a fire. In the afternoon, they learn forest skills, for example, how to build a shelter. They also learn about nature.

Jamie is a student at the school. He can climb trees very well, and he knows the names of many different plants, animals and birds. "I love my school," he says.
