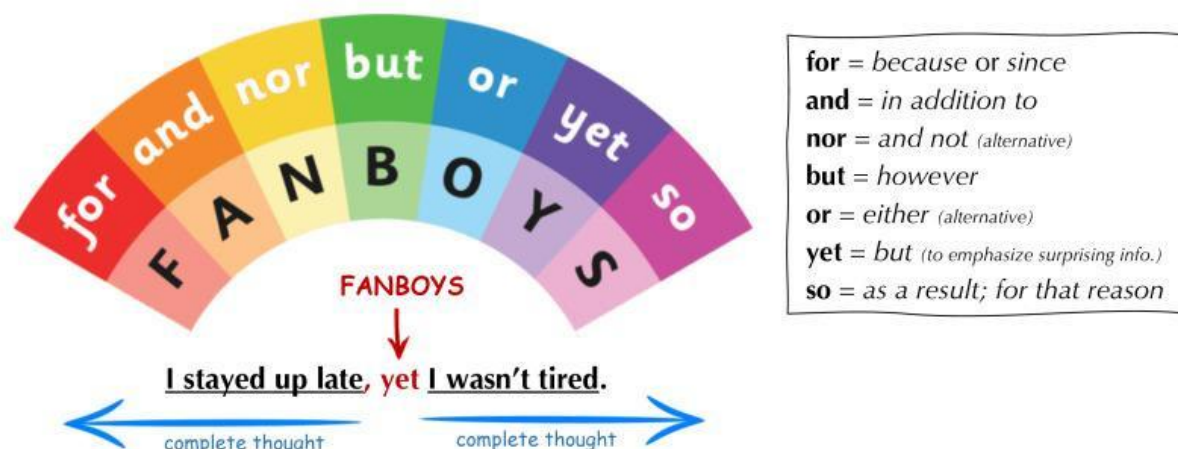


Writing Ex. > Linking Words (FANBOYS)
