LIFE IN A MAASAI VILLAGE

The Maasai people of Africa are famous all over the world. They speak a language called Maa and they live in Kenya and Tanzania. They are usually tall and thin and they often wear a shuka (shukas are the traditional red clothes of the Maasai).

Today I am in a Maasai village in Kenya. It is only six o'clock in the morning but it is very hot. The Maasai people get up early with the sun. I can see two old men with mobile phones near a tree.
