

A Or An

We use *A* in front of a consonant.

**A pineapple
Not *A* apple.**

Exception

If the word begins with the letter "h" and the "h" makes a sound you need to put the letter "a"

We use *AN* in front of a Vowel.

**A E I O U
An apple
Not *An* pineapple.**

Exception

If the word begins with the letter "u" and the "u" makes a sound different like "um" you need to put the letter "an"
