Articles: '**a**' and '**an**'

Instructions

1. Use '**a**' when the word starts with a consonant (letters that are not vowels: a, e, i, o, u).

Example: I have **a** cat.

2. Use '**an**' when the word starts with a vowel (the letters: a, e, i, o, u).

Example: She has **an** apple.



Remember, it's like putting on a hat: '**a**' for words that wear a consonant hat and '**an**' for words that wear a vowel hat!
